 Garvin (Premier Login Garvin2) Owner	<p>Hi Morgan</p> <p>It's a nice idea but I know from my experience of having a (very small) database on the Falke forum that inputting the numbers can become quite a pain.</p> <p>For various reasons it seems likely that a good percentage of vintage BSAs have survived and of course many tens of thousands were made, so it could be a massive undertaking!</p> <p>And there's no way on a forum like this that people can enter their own numbers into a single list, which in any case would probably quickly get out of control...</p> <p>But it would definitely be worth doing it for, say, Military Patterns or No.3 BSAs (.25 cal), of which relatively few were made and even fewer survive.</p> <p>:-)</p> <hr/> <p>The Falke forum The Vintage BSA Forum</p>	October 16 2010, 11:31 PM
