I have recently purchased this air pistol at auction (only paid £85, which i think was a steal)

Its in good condition for its age. Still works great. The only downside is the fact that it no longer has its original grips.

Instead it has a pair of shaped wooden grips, which to be frank, are actually quite comfortable to use, just looks bad.


Could not find any markings to tell me what caliber it is, but it is indeed a .177 model (A mark 2 , series 2 , version 2, 2nd variant whatever you want to call it. So not the rarer version but still very nice)
